










## START HERE

1. Identify the bottom of the Left and Right uprights by locating the flange with two large holes at the base. This indicates the bottom of these uprights. See Figure 1.
2. Identify the Center Upright. Look for "TOP" stamped on the Center Upright to face up. See Figure 2.
3. Before you begin, designate one side of your assembly as the front. Arrange the uprights so that all Offset Lips are positioned on the back side. See Figure 3.
4. Ensure the Center Upright's lips are positioned closest to the back as well. See Figure 3.

**NOTE:** The Offset Lips are where your back panels will rest. If lip is not lined up correctly, your back panels won't be able to slide in at installation.



LARGE HOLES AT THE BASE OF LEFT & RIGHT UPRIGHT INDICATE THE BOTTOM





"TOP" STAMP INDICATES THE TOP OF CENTER UPRIGHT


VIEW OF OFFSET LIPS ON UPRIGHTS ALIGNED FROM THE TOP




OFFSET UPRIGHT LIP






